



Contest Rules:

Open to all Adventure Princesses, Senior Princesses, Adventure Guides, Trail Blazers & Dads

- Boat can carry 1-3 passengers.
- Boat must be made of 1/8 inch wafer type cardboard (typical cardboard box material) only. No additional flotation objects (tubes, rubber tires, "noodles", etc) are permitted. This will be STRICTLY enforced.
- No use of fasteners, sealers or any other materials will be allowed e.g. you cannot paint the boat to seal it only use duct tape.
- · Boat must be no longer than 6 feet and no wider than 3 feet.
- Hand paddling only. Use of feet in the water to kick will result in disqualification. e.g. you
 cannot use a raft to do a free-style stroke. If your feet are in the water, likely you will be
 disqualified.
- · No paddles of any kind allowed. No taping of hands.
- All cardboard must be covered with duct tape. No exposed cardboard inside or outside of boat.
 Exposed cardboard will result in not being able to race (this is a cleanliness/safety issue).
- All participants are required to remove the remains of their boat from the premises immediately
 after their race. Boats are not to be left in the water to see how long they will float. The boats
 must be thrown away appropriately, there are potential fines/fees if cardboard boats remain.
 Do not leave your boat for someone else to throw in the dumpster.
- Participants who have been disqualified are to remove their boats from the water immediately
 upon being notified of disqualification.
- Participants are to get out of the pool immediately after completion of the race and carry their boat from the premises.
- · Racers are to arrange for disposal of their boat prior to race day.
- · Once the event starts no modifications or additions to boats are permitted.

Race Procedures:

Race will start from the deep end of the pool. Boats are to be placed in between each of the starting blocks. If enough boats are present, multiple heats will be run. Participants will set their boats in the water, once the whistle blows board the boat and start the race..

Participants are to **hand paddle only** down to the other end of the pool, and touch the side of the pool. Only one person needs to touch the side of the pool. The race is not finished until the participant touches the other side of the pool, a boat touching the side of the pool is not considered finishing. Participants must remain in their boat the entire time they are moving forward, if a participant falls out of the boat the boat may not advance until they are back in.

Participants are not allowed to travel down the side of the pool using the edge of the pool or lane dividers to propel the boat. Using the edge of the pool or lane dividers to propel the boat will result in disqualification.

Prizes: will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place for the Frontier / Best Decorated Boat 1st only for the Frontier / and Dad Race 1st only for the Frontier

Gather 'round for a tale from your Storyteller

How the Fawn Got Its Spots

From the Keweenaw Bay Ojibwa Community

Long ago, when the world was new, Wakan Tanka, "The Great Mystery" (God), was walking around. As he walked, he spoke to himself of the many things he had done to help the four-legged ones and the birds survive.



"It is good," Wakan Tanka said. "I have given Mountain Lion sharp claws and Grizzly Bear great Strength. It is much easier now for them to survive. I have given Wolf sharp teeth and I have given his little brother, Coyote, quick wits. It is much easier now for them to survive. I have given Beaver a flat tail and webbed feet to swim beneath the water and teeth which can cut down the trees. I have given slow-moving porcupine quills to protect itself. Now it is easier for them to survive. I have given the birds their feathers and the ability to fly so that they may escape their enemies. I have given speed to the deer and the rabbit so that it will be hard for their enemies to catch them. Truly it is now much easier for them to survive."

However, as Wakan Tanka spoke, a mother deer came up to him. Behind her was her small fawn, wobbling on weak new legs. "Great One," she said. "It is true that you have given many gifts to the four-leggeds and the winged ones to help them survive. It is true that you gave me great speed and now my enemies find it hard to catch me. My speed is a great protection, indeed. But what of my little one here? She does not yet have speed. It is easy for our enemies, with their sharp teeth and their claws, to catch her. If your children do not survive, how can my people live?"

"Wica Yaka Pelo!" said Wakan Tanka. "You have spoken truly; you are right. Have your little one come here and I will help her." Then Wakan Tanka made paint from the earth and the plants. He painted spots upon the fawn's body so that, when she lay still, her color blended in with the earth and she could not be seen. Then Wakan Tanka breathed upon her, taking away her scent.

"Now," Wakan Tanka said, "your little ones will always be safe if they only remain still when they are away from your side. None of your enemies will see your little ones or be able to catch their scent." So it has been from that day on. When a young deer is too small and weak to run swiftly, it is covered with spots that blend in with the earth. It has no scent and it remains very still and close to the earth when its mother is not by its side. And when it has grown enough to have the speed Wakan Tanka gave its people, then it loses those spots it once needed to survive.



Our Lesson:

As we begin this new Adventure Princesses year with our little fawns, let's do our best to help them grow into strong confident young ladies and shake off their spots, so one day we can watch them run swiftly through the forests of life.
