Buffalo Overnighter - Naval and Military Park! Saturday October 15 - 16

The Buffalo Overnighter aboard the USS Little Rock returns in 2022. The deadline to register has passed. Final payment is due day of the event. Cost: \$65 pp / deposit \$20 pp

Highlights:

Arrive between 330pm and 430PM (don't be late, they close down the check-in)

Includes Supper on arrival day, breakfast next morning, a movie and self-guided tours.

The ship and shipyard will be open at 830AM just for us until 10AM

Buffalo has some great activities including Niagara falls, the Anchor bar, the zoo and more.

What to bring:

Sleeping compartments are CO-ED, and each visitor is responsible for bringing his or her own sleeping items (bag, blanket, pillow, etc.), the bunks onboard do not have sheets or blankets. Also campers are advised to dress appropriately for the outside weather. Storage space is limited so pack minimally:

1. Personal toiletries.
2. Appropriate clothing. We recommend no high heels or flip-flops (remember the shipboard ladders are steep and during bad weather can get slippery).
3. Specific Special Dietary needs.
4. Card or board games, if desired.
5. First Aid Kit, the Naval and Military Park Staff will not dispense any medications or first aid supplies.

What not to bring:

1. Alcoholic beverages.
2. Coolers (unless authorized by Duty Officer).
3. Snacks, chewing gum, etc.
4. Drugs other than those prescribed for the individual by a medical doctor or over-the-counter medication.
5. Knives, Tools or Cutting implements.
6. Appliances, including coffee makers (Coffee and Tea is available on the USS Little Rock) hot plates, stoves, fueled lanterns.
7. Pets (guide animals are the only exceptions).
8. Items that may cause damage or injury.

Parking

For overnight parking, we recommend using the Cedarland Business Park Lot on Erie Street at the north end of Marine Drive (20 Wilkeson Way). Parking is generally free, although pricing may vary and is not controlled by the Buffalo Naval Park. 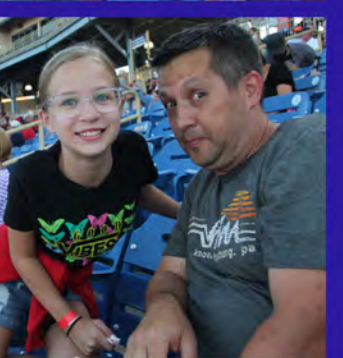
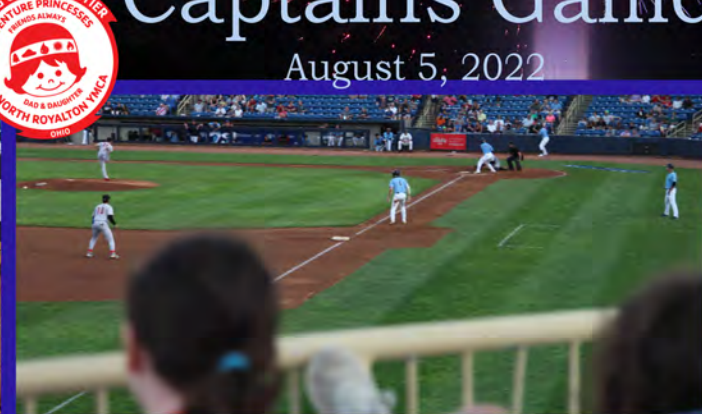
